

Dear Attorney Walters

Ms. **[deleted]** has indicated that you desire further information pertaining to our claims of infringement against your client...of our adult motion picture entitled "Raw Rescue". This infringement was initially detected via an ongoing investigation of the rampant infringement of our content on the BitTorrent file distribution network. Specifically, an actual download of the referenced title was effectuated from an electronic device connected to your client's IP address to an investigative server physically situated in the United States of America.

Attached is the Pure Bill of Discovery lawsuit which was filed to ascertain your client's identity. Pursuant to a subpoena, it was definitively confirmed by **[client's ISP]** that your client was the applicable subscriber in control of the IP address associated with Doe #**XXX** in the underlying lawsuit.

In the absence of an amicable settlement, we are left with no choice but to pursue your client. We estimate that BitTorrent based infringement has hit our bottom line to the tune of \$3,500,000 annually.
