



Seattle Kenneth L. Schubert Jr. 1L Diversity Fellowship Program

Schubert Jr. 1L Diversity Fellowship Program. This program honors one of our early founders, Ken Schubert Jr., who was a trailblazer in promoting diversity in the legal profession.

The fellowship is open to incoming first-year law students for the 2023-2024 academic year who represent a diverse range of backgrounds, including but not limited to, persons of color, women, LGBTQ+ individuals, and persons with disabilities. The recipient of the fellowship will be awarded a 10-week paid summer associate position in our Seattle office between their first and second year of law school. Upon completion of the summer associate position, the Diversity Fellow will receive a \$15,000 fellowship award (\$7,500 payable at the start of the first semester/quarter of the second year, and another \$7,500 payable at the start of the second semester/quarter of the second year upon the showing of continued outstanding academic performance).

Application Requirements & Process
